The committee is pleased to note that the campus continues to remain incident-free. This meeting will focus on maintaining this positive momentum as we transition into the next month of the academic session.

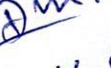

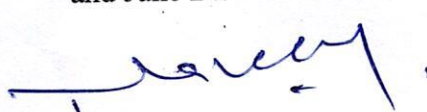

Let us work together to ensure that **DPS Bandikui** remains a sanctuary for learning and personal growth.

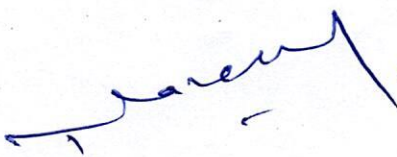
